<u>Ingredients</u>

Use two 20cm (8 inch) cake tins 170g (6oz) castor sugar

Must have a jam filling only 170g (6oz) butter Vanilla essence (a few drops)

A light dusting of icing sugar is acceptable as a topping 170g (6oz) self-raising flour jam for filling
