	<u>Reports from Borough and County Councillors</u> RBC Cllr Brennan reported that work across the boroughs has been undertaken for local government review and looking at an alternative proposal. In the cabinet the design guide will be endorsed. There will be work undertaken with the management companies of the new development to achieve best practice. The Forest ground planning permission has been granted. With the Local Government Review it is a challenging time for staff especially the planning teams are struggling - please be patient Cllr R Upton reported that the A52 roadworks with Cadent are appalling and he has tried to find a solution to the issues. MP James Naish is now on the case. The greenway is no further forward unfortunately. The Villager bus reliability issues, contacted Trent Barton who state these are small old buses which they are struggling to source spare parts. The Shelford Road zebra crossing is scheduled for September this is due to the

	Severn Trent contractors. Looking into the possibility of a further zebra crossing on Bingham Road by the school and will be talking with the school.
