	Chairs Welcome The Chair reported that the VJ day was on 15th August which went well but a bit disappointed of Councillor turnout. On 15th August there were dead fish reported at the Lily ponds due to the hot weather and lack of oxygen in the water, an interview was given by Notts TV. The portable toilet has had no issues this year hopefully the new position and the CCTV has protected it. Village Show is on Sunday - thanks to those who have already volunteered but more would be welcome please. The Local Government Reorganisation (LGR) is being debated in Parliament.
Open Forum	Open Forum A member of the public wished to raise concerns with regard to the Princes Place development with 8 new properties and questioned if a new entrance onto Shelford Road is required and not use an entrance off Flower Avenue instead, the survey of usage was not in fishing season and not representative of those who use the layby. They also raised concerns on the environment as bats and heat pumps not mentioned. They also stated that the new pictures in the Grange are nice.
	Reports from Borough and County Councillors Cllr Brennan and Cllr Clake gave their apologies Cllr Upton reported that there was a LGR debate at Nottinghamshire County Council and it was agreed to go with option 1B with Nottingham City, Broxtowe and Gedling becoming one unitary council and Nottinghamshire County Council, Rushcliffe, Mansfield, Newark as the other. This was agreed 43 for 11 against 1 abstention.
