Alternative options have been sought from Boots and Viola for funding. It was suggested that RBC/NCC may be able to offer grants for the scheme. The Council resolved unanimously to move forward with this proposal to the standard proposal once data obtained. c) Single Use plastic proposal 10 years ago there was a single use plastic policy to discourage its use by hirers, the proposal is to look at relaunching the policy. The Council resolved unanimously to go ahead to next phase of proposal.
