



Updates to bus services in Radcliffe On Trent.

We have had several residents unsure about the new bus services in Radcliffe on Trent. Following this, the Parish Council have received the following update from Nottinghamshire County Council:

While the 747 is new to Radcliffe on Trent, it's actually an extension of the existing 747 service, introduced to replace route 33 which itself has been replaced by the new service 11.

The 747 operates hourly Monday to Saturday between Oxton and Cropwell Bishop, serving Calverton, Lowdham, Gunthorpe, Radcliffe on Trent, Upper Saxondale and Cropwell Butler. The timetable has two main aims:

To provide a connection with the Nottingham City Transport 26 bus service at Lowdham a much-requested improvement for which through tickets are available.

To link communities north and south of Radcliffe on Trent to the village as the key interchange and destination for local amenities.

The current route via Clumber Drive and Queen's Drive was chosen to give as many residents as possible the shortest walking distance to the bus.
