

THE RIVERSIDE AND RADCLIFFE'S LILY PONDS –

A GUIDED WALK ON SATURDAY, MAY 30TH

Meet Phillip Taylor at 2 p.m. by Rockley Park entrance gates (top of Park Road) for a walk around this Local Wildlife Site. Find out more about the site, its history and its flora and fauna and how it is currently being managed by the community Nature Conservation Group with input from other wildlife organisations in partnership with Radcliffe Parish Council.

This walk is free and open to all and is part of Nottinghamshire Wildlife Trust's '*Out and About with Wildlife Programme 2026*'. No booking is required. The walk is expected to last around an hour and a half. Please note that access to the riverside is via a long set of steps from the Cliff Walk so a reasonable level of fitness and appropriate footwear is required. Please consider bringing a drink with you (plus sunhat!), especially if the weather is warm.
